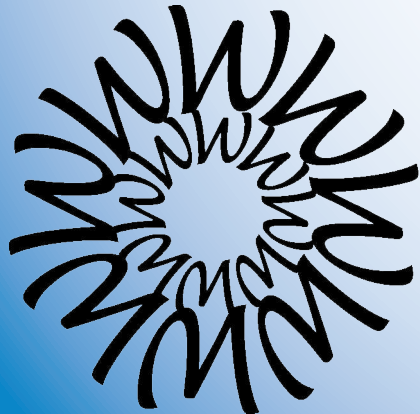

Their time, energy, and dedication provide much needed services to the women and children of this community.

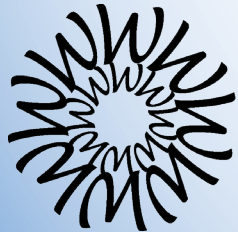
Getting Involved
